About Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc. and the Phi Kappa Zeta Chapter

Zeta Phi Beta Sorority Incorporated was founded January 16, 1920, on the campus of Howard University in Washington, D.C. Five coeds, Arizona Cleaver, Pearl Neal, Myrtle Tyler, Viola Tyler and Fannie Pettie were encouraged by Charles Robert Taylor and A. Langston Taylor, members of Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Incorporated, to form a sister organization. The sorority's principles are Scholarship, Sisterhood, Service, and "Finer Womanhood."

Phi Kappa Zeta Chapter (PKZ) was chartered on December 5, 2007, in Woodbridge, VA by eight women ranging in all professional backgrounds and age groups. PKZ programming primarily focuses on education/literacy, meeting the needs of women and children, and health/wellness.

The Phi Kappa Zeta Scholarship Fund

The Phi Kappa Zeta Scholarship Fund was established in January 2008. Shortly thereafter, the chapter expanded the scholarship award into a scholarship program, known as the Miss Phi Kappa Zeta Program. In addition to an opportunity to apply for scholarship awards, the program also offers young ladies opportunities for personal enrichment.

What is the Miss Phi Kappa Zeta Program?

In the spirit of our sorority's ideal of Finer Womanhood, the Miss Phi Kappa Zeta Scholarship Development Program is a personal enrichment program for young ladies. The program consists of workshops, social activities, and interviews conducted over the course of a weekend, known as "Scholarship Weekend." Applicants must meet the following Eligibility Requirements: residency in Prince William County; high school junior or senior; minimum GPA of 2.75 (on a 4.0 scale).

Calendar

The application period opens November 1, 2013. Packets MUST be mailed and postmarked by February 21, 2014. Scholarship Weekend will take place March 1-2, 2014. Award determinations will be finalized March 3, 2014 and notification letters will go out the following week. A formal presentation to the scholarship winners is scheduled to take place on March 15, 2014.

Responsibilities and Expectations

Each participant is required to make a personal investment and should be committed to attendance and full participation in **ALL** workshops, social activities, and interviews of this program. Each participant should adhere to all deadlines and administrative requirements. Each participant shall recognize that this development program is designed for the personal enrichment of all participants and shall do her part to ensure it is a pleasant environment for all.
